

**RAMBLIN EXPRESS CASINO SHUTTLE PASSENGERS
CAN PARK AT FEDERAL CENTER PnR WITHOUT CONCERN OF BEING TICKETED**

The situation has been discussed with the RTD Parking Manager and SP+ Parking, the RTD parking enforcement group, regarding problems with incorrect violations received at the Federal Center PnR.

A ticketing concern with the Federal Center PnR was identified by RTD in the past and in response our enforcement drivers implemented a new verification schedule. This schedule appears to have been effective as there have been only a few violations issued. We are hopeful this problem has actually been resolved.

We understand that casino employees may have long, overnight shifts. Further, we understand that Ramblin Express Casino Shuttle passengers may stay overnight at one of the many hotels in Black Hawk or Central City. Should a Ramblin Express Casino Shuttle passenger receive a violation (parking ticket) at Federal Center PnR, SP+ Parking places them on a list which alerts their enforcement agents scanning license plates in the future.

To ensure consistent resolve with all of our RTD patrons, it is important to address parking concerns in a consistent manner as well. It appears that RTD has a process in place that may address this matter and has succeeded in preventing excessive ticketing. RTD is confident SP+ Parking will continue to work diligently to maximize this efficiency.

Should any person receive a violation at the Federal Center PnR in error, they will need to reach out to the first point of contact: SP+ Parking at 303-292-1505

At this time the patron should alert SP+ Parking they were on the Ramblin Express Casino Shuttle and were parked less than 24-hours.
